



SPECIAL FINANCIAL AID SYSTEM FOR PRIVATELY-FINANCED STUDENTS AIMS 2014-2015 FALL SEMESTER PROGRAM

A university with 140 years of history and the first in Japan to focus on education and research in both fields of Agriculture and Engineering, Tokyo University of Agriculture and Technology (TUAT) is accepting students for the 1-Semester Exchange under the ASEAN International Mobility for Students (AIMS) Program starting from September 2014.

A Financial Aid System was exceptionally established for the first semester of the Program at TUAT, targeting ASEAN students who have not been awarded any scholarships or benefits exceeding the amount of 150,000JPY in total, but meet the academic requirements for admission and have a strong desire to study at TUAT.

TUAT provides:

- ★ Monthly allowance of **JPY25,000** for 4 months (Sept.-Dec. 2014) (approximately MYR 800; THB 8,000; IDR 2,900,000)
- ★ **free accommodation** at walking distance from TUAT campuses
- ★ **free registration and tuition fees** (for TUAT partner universities)

Students are responsible for:

- Round-trip air ticket to/from Japan
- Transportation (airport ↔ university)
- Visa fees
- Beddings and cooking utensils
- Food
- Other Personal expenses

Application Deadline at TUAT: **JUNE 30 (Monday) 2014**
